

PERFORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE SET FORTH IN THE ANNUAL PRIMARY HIGHWAY PROGRAM, IT SHALL, IF SO REQUESTED BY RESOLUTION OF EITHER HOUSE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, EXPLAIN IN WRITING TO THE NEXT SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ANY CHANGE IN THE SCHEDULING OF A PARTICULAR PROJECT INCLUDED IN THE PRECEDING YEAR'S PROGRAM.

(D) IF THERE IS ANY CHANGE IN THE SCHEDULING OF A PARTICULAR PROJECT IN THE SECONDARY HIGHWAY PROGRAM FOR WHICH FUNDS HAVE BEEN APPROPRIATED IN THE PRECEDING YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION, ON WRITTEN REQUEST OF A MAJORITY OF THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION FROM THE COUNTY FOR WHICH THE PROJECT IS PROGRAMMED, SHALL EXPLAIN THAT CHANGE IN WRITING TO THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM THAT COUNTY.

(E) THE ADMINISTRATION'S BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1981 AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING, AS SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL INCLUDE FUNDS FOR PROJECTS SCHEDULED FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.

8-613.1. ANNUAL STATUS REPORT.

ON BY JANUARY 4 15, 1980 AND ON BY JANUARY 4 15 OF EACH YEAR FOLLOWING, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH AFFECTED COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY A WRITTEN REPORT SETTING FORTH THE FOLLOWING FOR EACH PRIMARY AND SECONDARY HIGHWAY PROJECT:

(1) THE STATUS OF ALL INCOMPLETE PROJECTS FOR WHICH FUNDS HAVE BEEN APPROPRIATED OR EXPENDED FOR FISCAL YEARS COMPLETED BEFORE THE REPORT;

(2) A STATEMENT OF THE FUNDS BUDGETED OR EXPENDED ON EACH INCOMPLETE PROJECT IN THE FISCAL YEAR PRECEDING THE REPORT;

(3) A STATEMENT OF THE FUNDS EXPENDED OR EXPECTED TO BE EXPENDED IN THE THEN CURRENT FISCAL YEAR ON EACH INCOMPLETE PROJECT;

(4) A LIST OF ALL PROJECTS THAT WERE COMPLETED IN THE FISCAL YEAR PRECEDING THE REPORT; AND

(5) A STATEMENT OF THE TOTAL FUNDS BUDGETED AND EXPENDED ON EACH PROJECT COMPLETED IN THE FISCAL YEAR PRECEDING THE REPORT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department shall develop (1) proposed standards for determining the eligibility of projects for inclusion in the primary highway system, the secondary highway system, and any supplemental, maintenance, or other program maintained by the Department for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, or maintaining State highways and (2) a proposed procedure to be followed by the Department if it proposes to include a project, or a portion of a project, eligible for inclusion in the primary or secondary system in
