

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor - Executive and

(E) (1) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BALTIMORE PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS AND THE SUPERINTENDENT OF ANNAPOLIS PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN A SECURITY FORCE FOR THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTIES WHICH HE EACH IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING AND GUARDING. THE PURPOSE OF THIS EACH FORCE IS TO PROTECT PERSONS AND PROPERTY; TO DISPERSE ASSEMBLAGES WHICH ARE UNLAWFUL, DANGEROUS, OR OBSTRUCT FULL AND FREE PASSAGE; TO CONTROL PEDESTRIAN OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC; AND OTHERWISE TO PRESERVE AND TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, AND SAFETY. FOR THESE PURPOSES, A MEMBER OF THIS FORCE ONE OF THESE FORCES IS A PEACE AND POLICE OFFICER AND HAS THE SAME POWERS AS SHERIFFS, CONSTABLES, POLICE, AND PEACE OFFICERS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS.

~~(2) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BALTIMORE PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SHALL ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS AND PARKING REGULATIONS FOR CONTROL OF VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC ON OR WITHIN PARKING GARAGES, SURFACE PARKING LOTS, STREETS, AND SIDEWALKS ON OR WITHIN THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY WHICH HE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING AND GUARDING. FOR THESE PURPOSES, HE MAY ADOPT ANY ORDINANCES, LAWS, OR REGULATIONS CONTROLLING AND REGULATING PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, AND PROVIDE FOR THEIR IMPOUNDMENT, WHICH ARE IN EFFECT IN BALTIMORE CITY OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR MUNICIPALITIES IN WHICH THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY ARE LOCATED. HE SHALL CONSULT WITH THE BALTIMORE CITY TRANSIT AND TRAFFIC DEPARTMENT OR OTHER APPROPRIATE AGENCIES IN WHOSE JURISDICTION THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY ARE LOCATED TO ENSURE THAT ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS, SIGNALS, MARKINGS, AND DEVICES PLACED OR ERECTED ON OR WITHIN THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY ARE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE PLACED OR ERECTED BY BALTIMORE CITY OR THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR MUNICIPALITIES IN WHICH THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY ARE LOCATED. MEMBERS OF THE BALTIMORE PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY FORCE SHALL ISSUE CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PARKING REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BALTIMORE PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS WHICH ARE SIMILAR TO THE CITATIONS ISSUED FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS IN BALTIMORE CITY OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR MUNICIPALITIES IN WHICH THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY ARE LOCATED.~~
