

(2) A CHIROPRACTOR ON INACTIVE STATUS WHO DESIRES TO REGAIN ACTIVE STATUS SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS EXISTING IN THE YEAR HE WISHES TO RETURN TO ACTIVE STATUS, AND PAY A REINSTATEMENT FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 302

(Senate Bill 1270)

AN ACT concerning

Public Buildings - Illumination Standards

FOR the purpose of providing statewide illumination guidelines for existing public buildings; providing for development and promulgation of these guidelines and for certain training programs and assistance with respect to the guidelines; defining certain terms; and generally relating to illumination in public buildings.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "ASHRAF" MEANS THE ORGANIZATION KNOWN AS THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF HEATING, REFRIGERATING, AND AIR CONDITIONING ENGINEERS.
