- (A) A CERTIFICATE OR POLICY OF SICKNESS AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE OR OF AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES OR PAYS FOR HEALTH CARE BENEFITS MAY NOT CONTAIN ANY PROVISION THAT DENIES OR REDUCES BENEFITS BECAUSE SERVICES ARE RENDERED TO A CERTIFICATE OR POLICY HOLDER OR A BENEFICIARY WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR OR RECEIVING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE UNDER ARTICLE 43, §42 OF THE CODE.
 - (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- (1) ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFICATE OR POLICY AND ANY GROUP CERTIFICATE OR POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY TO A PERSON IN THIS STATE; AND
- (2) ALL OF THESE POLICIES AND CERTIFICATES THAT ARE ISSUED, RENEWED, MODIFIED, ALTERED, AMENDED, OR REISSUED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1978.
