- 4-303. POWER TO TAX AND PROTECT SCHOOL PROPERTY.
 - (A) POWER TO TAX FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.
- (1) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY LEVY AND COLLECT TAXES ON THE ASSESSABLE PROPERTY IN BALTIMORE CITY NECESSARY TO PAY ALL THE EXPENSES THEY INCURFOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.
- (2) THESE TAXES SHALL BE LEVIED AND COLLECTED AS ARE OTHER TAXES.
 - (B) PROTECTION OF SCHOOL PROPERTY.

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY ADOPT ORDINANCES:

- (1) FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND OTHER SCHOOL PROPERTY: AND
- (2). TO PUNISH ANY PERSON WHO DISTURBS THE SESSIONS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

- 4-304. POWERS AND DUTIES OF BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS.

SUBJECT TO THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY:

- (1) EXAMINE, APPOINT, AND REMOVE TEACHERS;
- (2) SET TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS;
- (3) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, SET TEACHER SALARIES; AND
- (4) SELECT TEXTBOOKS FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN BALTIMORE CITY, EXCEPT THAT THE TEXTBOOKS MAY NOT CONTAIN ANYTHING OF A SECTARIAN OR PARTISAN CHARACTER.
