State employment provisions to require work for a certain percentage of the normal work and to allow additional hours of work.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

- (a) For purposes of this section the following terms shall have the following indicated meanings:
- (2) Permanent part-time employment means working [on]
- (I) ON not [fewer] LESS than two days per workweek; AND
- (II) FOR NOT LESS THAN 50 PERCENT AND \underline{o}_R NOT MORE THAN 80 PERCENT OF THE NORMAL WORKWEEK FOR THE POSITION.
- (3) ["Workweek"] "PART-TIME WORKWEEK" means not fewer than 17 3/4 hours nor more than [30] 32 hours of work per week.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

Vehicle Laws - Finance Company Registration Plates

FOR the purpose of allowing a financial institution to drive a repossessed vehicle under special registration plates from the place of its repossession to a place of storage, from one place of storage to another, to or
