

COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION OR TO GIVE THE PATIENT OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE A REASONABLE WRITTEN EXPLANATION FOR ANY DELAY IN COMPLYING WITH THIS SUBSECTION SHALL SUBJECT THE HOSPITAL OR NURSING HOME TO A FINE OF \$300.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(u) (2) (viii) The extraction of sand, gravel, rock, stone, earth, or fill from borrow pits for highway construction purposes OR OTHER PUBLIC FACILITIES, if the work is performed under a bond, contract, and specifications of the Department which provide for and require reclamation of the area affected in the manner provided by this subtitle; or
