may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the State's Attorney in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the State's Attorney shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

Garrett County Sheriff - Salary Increase

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Garrett County Sheriff; and providing for the salary increase to take effect beginning the next term of office.

(m) (1) The Sheriff of Garrett County shall receive a salary of at least [\$11,500] \$13,900 and a sum set by the County Commissioners, for expenses. He shall employ deputies as needed, within the budgetary limits, at salaries of at least \$5,200 each, one of whom shall act as warden of the jail, and a matron for the jail who shall also perform clerical duties at the salary set by the Sheriff. He may employ additional special deputies whose compensation shall be approved by the County Commissioners.
