

REASON, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A QUALIFIED PERSON TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF THE MEMBER.

(F) THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION. HOWEVER, THEY SHALL RECEIVE ORDINARY AND REASONABLE EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS NECESSARILY INCURRED WHILE DISCHARGING THEIR DUTIES AS MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

(G) IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO:

(1) PARTICIPATE IN THE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH;

(2) REVIEW BIENNIALLY THE OPERATION, IDENTIFY ISSUES AND PRIORITIES OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH, AND MAKE A REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

3.

(A) THE DIRECTOR FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH SHALL MEET THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

(1) HOLD A MASTER'S DEGREE IN HEALTH, EDUCATION, SOCIAL WORK, CHILD DEVELOPMENT, OR ANOTHER FIELD CLOSELY RELATED TO CHILDREN; AND

(2) HAVE AT LEAST FIVE YEARS OF INCREASING RESPONSIBILITY IN ADMINISTERING PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN.

(B) HIS DUTIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

(1) THE SUPERVISION OF THE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE;

(2) EXAMINATION OF ALL PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND PLANS FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING DUPLICATIONS, OR INEFFICIENCIES, EFFECTIVE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROGRAMS, RESOURCES, AND UNMET NEEDS;

(3) SECURING AND ANALYZING ALL DEPARTMENTAL PLANS AND BUDGET REQUESTS AFFECTING CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS AND SERVICES;

(4) REVIEW OF ALL FEDERAL FUNDS UTILIZED AND AVAILABLE TO THE STATE FOR CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS AND SERVICES;

(5) COLLATION OF ITEMS IN THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET RELATED TO PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH AND ISSUANCE OF ANNUAL IMPACT STATEMENTS;

(6) FORMULATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE DEPARTMENT HEADS ON PLANNING AND EXPENDITURES FOR CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS AND SERVICES;
