CHAPTER 437

(Senate Bill 181)

AN ACT concerning

State Medical Assistance Program - Financial Eligibility-Drugs

FOR the purpose of requiring that regulations of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall include as—a—deduction—from a person sincome the anticipated menthly cost to operate a Pharmacy Assistance Program for certain persons whose income—does not exceed a certain level; and requiring the Pharmacy Assistance Program to pay for all legend drugs for certain persons except for a certain copayment for each prescription of medicines and medical appliances; and providing for alternative methods of establishing—the anticipated menthly cost assets and gross annual income do not exceed certain levels; and requiring the Pharmacy Assistance Program to reimburse providers for certain prescription drugs up to a certain amount and subject to a certain copayment.
