CHAPTER 454

(Senate Bill 318)

AN ACT concerning

Homicide by Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated

FOR the purpose of providing that any person causing the death of another as the result of his <u>negligent</u> driving, operation or control of a motor vehicle while intoxicated is guilty of a misdemeanor; specifying a name for the misdemeanor; setting the penalties for the misdemeanor; specifying that an indictment for the crime need not contain certain information; providing a form for the indictment; and defining intoxicated as it relates to this crime; and removing an obsolete reference.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

388A.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION "INTOXICATED" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS INDICATED IN AND IS SUBJECT TO THE SAME PRESUMPTIONS AND EVIDENTIARY RULES OF § 10-307 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE REGARDING INTOXICATION UNDER THE VEHICLE LAWS OF THIS STATE.
 - (B) ANY PERSON CAUSING THE DEATH OF ANOTHER AS THE
