NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 59 OR THE PROVISIONS OF ANY OTHER LAW, WHEN A PSYCHOLOGIST CERTIFIED UNDER THE "PSYCHOLOGISTS" CERTIFICATION ACT" IS AND QUALIFIED AS AN EXPERT WITNESS, TESTIMONY BY THAT PSYCHOLOGIST IS ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE MAY TESTIFY ON ULTIMATE ISSUES, INCLUDING INSANITY, COMPETENCY TO STAND TRIAL, AND MATTERS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THAT PSYCHOLOGIST'S SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE, AND OTHER BELATED CIVIL AND CRIMINAL HATTERS IN ANY CASE IN ANY COURT OR IN ANY ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING.

(Senate Bill 651)

Vehicle Dealers - Definition for Licensing Purposes
