"Truck" means a motor vehicle, EXCEPT A MULTIPURPOSE PASSENGER VEHICLE, that is designed, used, or maintained primarily to carry property. HOWEVER, A VAN USED TO CARRY PROPERTY EXCLUSIVELY FOR NONCOMMERCIAL PURPOSES MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED A TRUCK.

(a) When registered with the Administration, every passenger car [and], station wagon, AND VAN, INCLUDING THOSE USED TO CARRY PROPERTY EXCLUSIVELY FOR NONCOMMERCIAL PURPOSES, except as otherwise provided in this part, is a Class A (passenger) vehicle.

13-412.

(b) Class A (passenger) [and], Class D (motorcycle) AND CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) registrations and registration plates expire on March 31 of each succeeding year.

13-937.

(A) WHEN REGISTERED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION, EVERY MULTIPURPOSE PASSENGER VEHICLE IS A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.

(B) FOR EACH CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE, THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE IS \$30.:

(1) FOR A VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S SHIPPING WEIGHT OF 3,700 POUNDS OR LESS - \$20; AND

(2) FOR A VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S SHIPPING WEIGHT OF MORE THAN 3,700 POUNDS - \$30.

(C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY BY RULE AND REGULATION, PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION OF ALL MULTIPURPOSE PASSENGER VEHICLES REGISTERED UNDER ANOTHER CATEGORY.

(h) (1) "Vehicle" means, except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any vehicle registered or to be registered in this State as:

(i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;

(II) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE;

[(ii)] (III) A Class J (van pool) vehicle;

[(iii)] (IV) A Class E (truck) vehicle, if it has a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity; or
