(C) (1) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE AND THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL ADOPT STANDARDS, QUALIFICATIONS, AND PREREQUISITES OF CHARACTER, TRAINING, EDUCATION, HUMAN AND PUBLIC RELATIONS, AND EXPERIENCE FOR UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE POLICE OFFICERS, INCLUDING STANDARDS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

(2) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT STANDARDS THAT ARE SIMILAR TO THE STANDARDS ADOPTED FOR THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE.

(3) STANDARDS ADOPTED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1978, ON MINIMUM HIRING QUALIFICATIONS OF UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE POLICE OFFICERS MAY NOT AFFECT THE STATUS OF ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS A QUALIFIED UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE POLICE OFFICER ON THAT DATE.

(D) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE OPERATION AND CONDUCT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE POLICE FORCE AND OF UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE POLICE OFFICERS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
