ANY NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN WHICH ISSUES OR DELIVERS A HEALTH HOSPITAL INSURANCE CERTIFICATE POLICY TO ANY PERSON IN THIS STATE SHALL OFFER A CATASTROPHIC HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY WHICH PROVIDES FULL COVERAGE FOR THE REASONABLE COST OF NECESSARY HEALTH CARE INCURRED BY THE MEMBER UP TO \$1,000,000. THE POLICY MAY PROVIDE FOR:

- (1) A \$50,000 DEDUCTIBLE PER BENEFIT PERIOD, WHICH DEDUCTIBLE MAY BE SATISFIED BY THE INSURED'S BASIC OR MAJOR MEDICAL HEALTH COVERAGE; AND
- 42) A-20-PIRCENT-MEMBER-COPAYMENT-AFTER-THE DEDUCTIELE IS MET, -PROVIDED THAT THE MEMBER'S COPAYMENT DOES NOT EXCEID-\$3,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

(Senate Bill 895)

AN ACT concerning

Economic Impact - Administrative Agency Rules and Regulations
