- (E) WITH THE CCNSENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL HITIDRAW MAY REMOVE OBSOLETE REGULATIONS OF PARTS OF REGULATIONS FROM THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS WHEN:
- (1) THE REGULATIONS ARE DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL BY A COURT OF FINAL APPEAL; OR
- (2) THE PROMULGATING ADOPTING AGENCY CEASES TO EXIST AND THE REGULATIONS ARE NOT TRANSFERRED TO A SUCCESSOR AGENCY UNDER ARTICLE 41, §8.

256-I.

- (E) WHEN A REGULATION, IN WHOLE CR IN PART, IS DECLARED INVALID AND UNCONSTITUTIONAL BY A COURT OF FINAL AFPEAL, THE ADOPTING AGENCY SHALL GIVE NOTICE TO THAT EFFECT IN THE REGISTER. THE AIMINISTRATOR ALSO SHALL GIVE NOTICE IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.
