CHAPTER 562

(Senate Bill 1197)

AN ACT concerning

Wicomico County-Alcoholic Beverages -  
Temporary Licenses

FOR the purpose of altering the fee charged in Wicomico County for certain temporary alcoholic beverage licenses.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
Section 25(b) and (c)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1977 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

25.

(t) (1) Special beer license, Class C, or a special beer and wine license, Class C, which entitles the holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by the respective classes of licenses for the use of any person holding any bona fide entertainment conducted by any club, society or association at the place described, for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days from the effective date thereof, upon the payment of a fee of \$5 per day.

(2) In Prince George's County the fee is \$10 per day.

(3) In Anne Arundel County the fee is \$10 per day.

(4) In Baltimore County the fee for this license is \$10 per day, except that for any bona fide religious, fraternal, civic, war veterans', hospital or charitable organization, the fee for this license is \$5.

(5) IN WICOMIC COUNTY THE FEE IS \$10 PER DAY.
