[(d) Each wrecker and each scrap processor shall keep each record required by this section for at least 3 years after the transaction to which it applies.]

[(a) (1) Each licensee shall keep the records that the Administration requires.

(2) During business hours, the records of the licensee shall be open to inspection by the Administration.

(b) Each licensee shall maintain all vehicles used for instruction in the condition that the Administration requires.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 589

(House Bill 305)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Vehicle Auctions

FOR the purpose of requiring certain persons auctioning certain vehicles in this State to maintain certain records relating thereto; providing for inspections of such records by the Motor Vehicle Administration; and providing that such records be retained for a certain time period.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
