- (A) EACH PERSON WHO AUCTIONS—IN THIS—STATE CONDUCTS

 A RECORD OF:
 - (1) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE CONSIGNOR;
 - (2) THE DATE ON WHICH IT WAS CONSIGNED:
- (3) THE YEAR, MAKE, MODEL, AND SERIAL NUMBER OF EACH VEHICLE CONSIGNED:
- (4) THE TITLE NUMBER AND STATE WHERE THE VEHICLE WAS LAST REGISTERED;
- (5) THE ODOMETER MILEAGE READING AT THE TIME OF CONSIGNMENT;
- (6) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON TO WHOM THE VEHICLE WAS SOLD;
 - (7) THE SEILING PRICE; AND
 - (8) THE DATE OF SALE: AND
- 49) ANY --- OTHER --- INFORMATION --- THAT --- THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.
- (B) DURING BUSINESS HOURS, THE RECORDS SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (C) THE RECORDS FEQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE KEPT FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER THE TRANSACTION TO WHICH IT APPLIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 590

(House Bill 306)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Nonresident Driver Registration

FOR the purpose of requiring certain nonresident drivers to obtain a nonresident's permit from the Motor Vehicle Administration; redefining "resident" for purposes of this article; defining "domicile" for purposes of this article; exempting from registration for a certain period of time the vehicle of a new Maryland resident;
