

(A) ~~EA~~CH PERSON WHO ~~AUCTIONS IN THIS STATE~~ CONDUCTS AUCTIONS AS A BUSINESS IN THIS STATE OF MOTOR VEHICLES OF A TYPE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL KEEP A RECORD OF:

- (1) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE CONSIGNOR;
- (2) THE DATE ON WHICH IT WAS CONSIGNED;
- (3) THE YEAR, MAKE, MODEL, AND SERIAL NUMBER OF EACH VEHICLE CONSIGNED;
- (4) THE TITLE NUMBER AND STATE WHERE THE VEHICLE WAS LAST REGISTERED;
- (5) THE ODCMETER MILEAGE READING AT THE TIME OF CONSIGNMENT;
- (6) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON TO WHOM THE VEHICLE WAS SOLD;
- (7) THE SELLING PRICE; AND
- (8) THE DATE OF SALE; ~~AND~~
- ~~(9) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.~~

(B) DURING BUSINESS HOURS, THE RECORDS SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

(C) THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE KEPT FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER THE TRANSACTION TO WHICH IT APPLIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

(House Bill 306)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Nonresident Driver Registration

FOR the purpose of requiring certain nonresident drivers to obtain a nonresident's permit from the Motor Vehicle Administration; redefining "resident" for purposes of this article; defining "domicile" for purposes of this article; exempting from registration for a certain period of time the vehicle of a new Maryland resident;
