- (I) LENGTH OF SERVICE; AND
- (II) SENIORITY AND STATUS.
- (2) THE REEMPLOYEE IS ENTITLED TO ALL BENEFITS AND PRIVILEGES, INCLUDING RATE OF PAY, THAT ATTACH TO THE SENIORITY AND STATUS.
- (3) THE PENSION AND RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF A REEMPLOYEE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY ARTICLE 65, §88 OF THE CODE.

SUBTITLE 3. SALARIES.

6-301. MINIMUM SALARY REQUIREMENTS.

(A) SCHEDULE OF MINIMUM TEACHER SALARIES.

EACH TEACHER REGULARLY EMPLOYED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF A COUNTY WHO HOLDS THE FOLLOWING DESIGNATED TYPE OF CERTIFICATE, AS DETERMINED BY THE BYLAWS OF THE STATE BOARD, OR WHO HAS EQUIVALENT STATUS IN BALTIMORE CITY, AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY FOR THE 10-MONTH SCHOOL YEAR OF AT LEAST THE AMOUNT LISTED IN THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE, FOR THE APPLICABLE YEAR OF TEACHING:
