SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1978) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

## Article-38A -- Fires-and-Investigations

In-addition to performing the duties and providing the services fermerly-provided-by-the-extension, the institute shall:
