- (2) The board shall consist of five trustees as follows:
- (a) The State Superintendent of Education, ex officio.
  - (b) The State Comptroller, ex officio.
  - (c) The State Treasurer, ex officio.
- Two [teachers who shall be] members 08 BINEFICIARIES of the system fand who shall be elected by the members-AND-BENEFICIARIES-of the system for -a term of four-years-according-to-such-rules-and-regulations as-the board-of-trustees-shall-adopt-to-govern-such-election, provided however, that the term of office of the first two trustees-se-elected-shall-begin-immediately-following-their election and shall expire August 1, 1929, and August 1, TRUSTEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OR SYSTEM AND NOT HORE THAN ONE OF WHOM 1931, -- respectively. BENEFICIARIES OF THE MAY BE A BENEFICIARY OF THE SYSTEM. THE TRUSTEES SHALL ELECTED BY THE MEMBERS AND THE BENEFICIARIES OF THE SYSTEM FOR TERMS OF FOUR YEARS EACH. ELECTIONS OF TRUSTEES SHALL BE CCNDUCTED PURSUANT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

- (f) Two-members-[of-the-enforcement-personnel of-the-Department-of-State-Police] OR-BENEFICIARIES-OF-THE SYSTEM-who-shall-be-appointed-for-terms-of-four-(4) years-by the-Board-of-Public-Werks-
