The term "Moving Fisture Machine Operator," as used in this sub-heading, shall be defined as and including any and all persons engaged—in the operation—of moving picture machines.—A license—of—moving—picture—machine—operator issued—in accordance—with the provisions—of—this—sub-heading shall—entitle—any—such—person—so—licensed—to-operate—any moving—picture—machine.

11-3-

The-Governor, with-the-advice-of-the-Secretary of Licensing-and-Regulation, shall-biennially-appoint in and for Baltimore-City-three persons: one from the Maryland Fire Underwriters! Rating Euroau, one licensed motion picture machine-operator,-a-member-of-the-Moving-Picture-Operators-Union, and one exhibiter duly licensed to operate motion picture - machines; all-of whom have had not less than three years -- experience-at-the-business-and-who-have-resided in Baltimore - City for a period of not less than two years next preceding-their-appointment, who shall be known as the Beard of Examining Moving Picture Machine Operators. The Board of Examining-Moving-Picture-Machine Operators shall be a part of the Department of Licensing and Regulation. The parties so-appointed shall-make oath before the Clerk of the Superior -- Court that they will faithfully perform the duties ef-their-effice, and shall-give-bend in the sum of five hundred-dollars, to be approved by the Judge of the Superior Court-of-Baltimore-City- The-exercise or performance-of-all pouces, -- authority, duties and functions vested in the Beard by the provisions of this subtitle, shall be subject to the power-and-authority-of-the-Secretary-of-Licensing and Regulation-as-set forth-in-Article-41-of-the-Annotated-Code of Maryland, or elsewhere in the laws of this State.

11-4-

All-persons-who,-on-May-1,-1910,-are-engaged-in-the business-of-a-moving-picture-machine-operator-in-the-Gity-of Baltimere,-as-described-in-Section-11-2,-shall-within-sixty days-after-the-first-day-of-May-1910,-comply-with-all-the provisions-of-this-sub-heading,-otherwise-they-shall-be guilty-of-a-misdemeanor,-and-upon-conviction,-be-fired-a-sur not-less-than-five-dollars,-nor-more-than-twenty-dollars,
