

competency and safety in the handling of firearms and successfully completed such a course of instruction.] THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AND SAFETY TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 18 UNLESS HE HAS COMPLETED SATISFACTORILY THE COURSE OF INSTRUCTION, OR PRODUCES A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY OR A HUNTING LICENSE ISSUED PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1978 OR MAKES OUT AN AFFIDAVIT THAT HE HAD SUCH A LICENSE.

(d) The Department shall adopt rules and regulations to provide for the course of instruction and the issuance of the certificates CONSISTENT WITH THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 650

(House Bill 1113)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Special Class D License)

FOR the purpose of providing for the distribution of certain moneys collected for a certain alcoholic beverage license in Garrett County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2E - Alcoholic Beverages

(1) (1) In Garrett County one half of such license fee shall be paid by the clerk of the Circuit Court to the mayor and council of the incorporated town in which such licensed premises may be located.
