(D) THE COURT MAY IMPOSE REASONABLE COURT COSTS AGAINST A RESPONDENT, CR THE RESPONDENT'S PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR CUSTODIAN, AGAINST WHOM A FINDING OF DELINQUENCY HAS BEEN ENTEREL UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
