- (5) Unless a public hearing is requested by the parent or guardian of the student, a hearing shall be held out of the presence cf all individuals except those whose presence is considered necessary or desirable by the board.
- (6) The appeal to the county board does not stay the decision of the county superintendent.
 - (7) The decision of the county board is final.
- (D) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY CNLY.
- (2) ANY STUDENT EXPELLED OR SUSPENDED FROM SCHOOL SHALL REMAIN AWAY FROM THE SCHOOL PREMISES DURING THOSE HOURS FACH SCHOOL DAY WHEN THE SCHOOL THE STUDENT ATTENDS IS IN SESSION.
- (3) THE EXPELLED OR SUSPENDED STUDENT MAY RETURN TO THE SCHOOL PREMISES DURING THE PROHIBITED HOURS ONLY FOR ATTENDANCE AT A PREVIOUSLY SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT, AND IF THE STUDENT IS A MINOR THEN ONLY IF ACCOMPANIED BY HIS PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
- (4) ANY STUDENT-18-YEARS OF AGE OR OVER OR ANY PARENT-OR-GUARDIAN-OF A STUDENT, UNDER 18-YEARS OF AGE, PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND CN CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
