FCR the purpose of changing the fee for auctioneers selling real property at tax sales in a certain county.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes Section 76 (g) (iv) Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1977 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes

76.

- (g) The following expenses relating to the sale shall be allowed, all of which shall be liens on the property to be sold:
- (iv) The auctioneer's fee, which—fin no case shall exceed ten dcllars (\$10.00) for any day when one, two or three properties are sold; and for any day when four or more properties are sold the fee shall be three dollars (\$3.00) for each property sold—] SHALL BE \$50 PER PROPERTY, UP-TO-A-MAXIMUM OF \$200 PER DAY .HOWEVER, IN WICCMICO COUNTY THE AUCTICHEER'S FEE SHALL BE \$10 FOR EACH PROPERTY SOLD, BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE AUCTIONEER'S FEE EE LESS THAN \$50 PER DAY OF GREATER THAN \$200 PER DAY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

Municipal Infractions
