

TO ASCERTAINING FROM THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF A STUDENT IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS:

- (1) THEIR LEGAL RESIDENCE; AND
- (2) THE DURATION OF THEIR RESIDENCY IN THIS STATE.

(D) ATTESTATION; WITNESSES.

THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WHO COMPLETE THE AFFIDAVIT OF DISCLOSURE SHALL ATTEST TO THE TRUTH OF THE INFORMATION IN THE AFFIDAVIT BY THEIR SIGNATURE WHICH SHALL BE WITNESSED BY THE INDIVIDUALS DESIGNATED BY THE COUNTY BOARD UNDER APPROPRIATE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(E) PENALTY.

(1) FAILURE TO COMPLETE THE AFFIDAVIT OF DISCLOSURE TRUTHFULLY BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IS A MISDEMEANOR.

(2) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$250.

7-103. REQUIRED SCHOOL DAYS AND HOLIDAYS.

(A) SCHOOLS TO BE OPEN FOR 180 DAYS.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE KEPT OPEN:

(1) FOR AT LEAST 180 ACTUAL SCHOOL DAYS DURING A 10-MONTH PERIOD OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR; AND

(2) EXCEPT ON SATURDAY, SUNDAY, AND HOLIDAYS, FOR AT LEAST 6 HOURS EACH DAY DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR.

(B) ADJUSTMENTS IN SCHOOL YEAR.

(1) IF A COUNTY BOARD SUBMITS A WRITTEN APPLICATION TO THE STATE BOARD THAT DESCRIBES A DEMONSTRATED EFFORT BY THE COUNTY BOARD TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD MAY PERMIT:

(I) ADJUSTMENTS IN THE LENGTH OF THE SCHOOL YEAR;

(II) EXCEPTIONS FROM THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE SCHOOL YEAR BE COMPLETED WITHIN A 10-MONTH PERIOD;
