AN ACT concerning

Chartered Counties of Maryland - Express Powers

~~FOR the purpose of permitting certain counties to pass enabling legislation to issue certain general obligation bonds as permitted in the Constitution; and providing that this Act is contingent upon the ratification of a Constitutional Amendment to Article III of the Constitution of the State of Maryland.~~

FOR the purpose of restating the law permitting chartered counties to pass enabling legislation to issue certain general obligation bonds; and providing that such law constitutes a grant of legislative authority and does not limit the authority vested in chartered counties under the subsection of the express powers act for such counties relating to bonds or evidences of indebtedness.
