clarifying the defense of certain criminal actions by the Attorney General; expanding the State Insurance Trust Fund to include all sums appropriated for the purpose of paying a grant made by the Board of Public Works to a State officer or employee; authorizing the State Treasurer to provide self-insurance for losses sustained by employees if such losses are certified as payable by the Board of Public Works; and generally relating to the defense of certain civil actions instituted against certain public officers or employees and the payment of certain judgments or settlements rendered against certain public officers or public employees.
