7-307. SEARCHES OF STUDENTS AND SCHOOLS.

(A) AUTHORITY TO SEARCH STUDENT.

(1) A PRINCIPAL, ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL, OR SCHOOL SECURITY GUARD OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY MAKE A REASONABLE SEARCH OF A STUDENT ON THE SCHOOL PREMISES IF HE HAS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE THAT THE STUDENT HAS IN HIS POSSESSION AN ITEM, THE POSSESSION OF WHICH IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.

(2) THE SEARCH SHALL BE MADE IN THE PRESENCE OF A THIRD PARTY.

(B) AUTHORITY TO SEARCH SCHOOL.

(1) A PRINCIPAL, ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL, OR SCHOOL SECURITY GUARD OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY MAKE A SEARCH OF THE PHYSICAL PLANT OF THE SCHOOL AND ITS APPURTENANCES INCLUDING THE LOCKERS OF STUDENTS.

(2) THE RIGHT OF THE SCHOOL OFFICIAL TO SEARCH THE LOCKER SHALL BE ANNOUNCED OR PUBLISHED PREVIOUSLY IN THE SCHOOL.

(C) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE SEARCHES PERMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

7-401. SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM.

(A) DUTY OF COUNTY BOARD.

WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE:
