An individual's number of dependents shall be determined as of the day with respect to which he first files a valid claim for benefits in any benefit year, and shall be fixed for the duration of such benefit year. No person who has been determined to be a child of one individual on the beginning date of such individual's benefit year shall be deemed to be a child of any other individual whose benefit year starts within one year thereafter. Dependents' allowances shall be regarded as benefits for the purpose of computing contribution rates under the terms of § 8 (c) of this article.]~~

~~Any unemployed individual is eligible to receive benefits with respect to any week only if the Executive Director finds that:~~

~~(f) (2) An individual may not be paid benefits based on COVERED service performed [before January 1, 1978] in AN instructional, research, or principal administrative capacity in an institution of higher education for any week of unemployment that begins BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1978, during the period between two successive academic years, or during a similar period between two regular terms, whether or not successive, or during a period of paid sabbatical leave for which the individual's contract provides, if the individual has a contract or contracts to perform any of those services for any institution of higher education for both years or terms.~~

~~(3) An individual may not be paid benefits based on COVERED service performed [after December 31, 1977] in an instructional, research, or principal administrative capacity for an educational institution for any week of unemployment that begins AFTER DECEMBER 31, 1977 during a period of paid sabbatical leave for which the individual's contract provides or during the period between two successive academic years or a similar period between two regular but not successive terms, if the individual performs the service in the first year or term and there is a contract or reasonable assurance that the individual will perform services in such capacity for SUCH an educational institution in the second year or term.~~

~~(4) An individual may not be paid benefits based on COVERED service performed [after December 31, 1977] in any capacity other than instructional, research, or principal administrative for any educational institution THAT IS NOT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION for any week OF UNEMPLOYMENT that begins AFTER DECEMBER 31, 1977, during a period between two successive academic years or terms, if the individual performs the service in the first year or term and there is a reasonable assurance that the individual will perform the service in the second year or term.~~
