The basic rates in the above table INCREASED BY 4-5 2.0 PERCENT shall apply for the fiscal year beginning [July 1, 1972, and for] JULY 1, 1978 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL AN EMPLOYER BE REQUIRED TO PAY A TOTAL CONTRIBUTION RATE GREATER THAN 5.0 PERCENT. FOR any fiscal year beginning on or after [July 1, 1973,] JULY 1, 1979 when the fund balance on the computation date equals or exceeds [3%] 2-3 4-5 PERCENT but is not in excess of [4.5%] 3-4 5.5 PERCENT of the total -[-taxable-]- wages IN COVERED EMPLOYMENT for the immediately preceding calendar year, THE TABLE OF EASIC RATES SEALL APPLY.

For the purposes of this subsection, the term "fund balance" means the total amount available for benefits in the unemployment insurance fund, including amounts receivable by the fund as federal reimbursements for sharable benefits under the "Federal-State Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 1970" and all amounts receivable from any eligible employer who elects to reimburse the fund for kenefit charges to his account in lieu of contributions and the term "total —f-taxable—j-wages" means—f-the wages—j-REMUNEMATION paid in a calendar year by all employers subject to this article[, which wages were subject to contributions and reported to the Executive Director], EXCEPT THE-TERM-DOES NOT-INCLUDE REMUNERATION—BY THE-STATE,—ANY-POLITICAL-SUBDIVISION—OR-NY-GOVERNMENTAL-OR
