CHAPTER 808

(Senate Bill 405)

AN ACT concerning

Regulatory Programs Evaluation

FOR the purpose of maintaining a healthy State economy and a government that has the confidence of its citizens by establishing a system of periodic legislative review of State regulatory and licensing activities; establishing a schedule for the evaluation of certain State offices and entities; terminating the legal effect of statutory provisions creating these offices and entities, provisions relating to their functions, and regulations promulgated by them; providing for the reestablishment of these offices and entities for a certain period; making the subsequent termination and evaluation of these offices and entities subject to the provisions of this Act, unless specifically provided otherwise by law; requiring certain legislative committees prepare an evaluation plan for each office or entity by a certain date; requiring the Department of Fiscal Services to prepare an evaluation report on the office or entity by a certain date; requiring the legislative committees to hold public hearings on the report and to make recommendations to the General Assembly; requiring offices and entities under review to requested information and cooperate in the evaluation; providing for the continuance in office of persons in reestablished offices or entities, except as provided otherwise by law; preserving certain claims and rights of against terminated offices and entities;
