

(15) AMUSEMENT SAFETY ADVISORY BOARD (ART. 89, SEC. 69).

486. REESTABLISHMENT.

(A) IF ANY BOARD MADE SUBJECT BY THIS ACT TO TERMINATION AND EVALUATION IS SUBSEQUENTLY REESTABLISHED BY STATUTE, SUCH REESTABLISHMENT IS FOR A PERIOD OF SIX YEARS, AT WHICH TIME THE BOARD IS AGAIN TERMINATED AND MADE SUBJECT TO EVALUATION PURSUANT TO THIS ACT, UNLESS THE REESTABLISHING STATUTE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDES OTHERWISE.

(B) BEFORE JULY 1 OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE EVALUATION DATE OF A BOARD UNDER SECTION 485 OF THIS ACT, A SENATE COMMITTEE DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT ~~AND~~ OR A HOUSE COMMITTEE DESIGNATED BY THE SPEAKER SHALL ~~JOINTLY~~ PREPARE A PLAN FOR THE EVALUATION OF THE BOARD AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD, THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES. AN EVALUATION PLAN MUST PROVIDE FOR PERIODIC CONSULTATION BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING, THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES, AND THE RELEVANT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES.

(C) BEFORE NOVEMBER 15 OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE EVALUATION DATE OF A BOARD UNDER SECTION 485 OF THIS ACT, ~~THE DESIGNATED COMMITTEE, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF~~ THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES, SHALL PREPARE AN EVALUATION REPORT BASED ON THE EVALUATION PLAN ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (B). ~~THE DEPARTMENT COMMITTEE~~ DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND MAKE COPIES AVAILABLE TO INTERESTED PARTIES AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

(D) THE EVALUATION REPORT SHALL DISCUSS:

(1) THE PURPOSE OF THE REGULATION AND THE MANNER OF OPERATION OF THE BOARD DESIGNED TO ACHIEVE THE PURPOSE;

(2) ANY CHANGE IN CONDITIONS SINCE THE REGULATION WAS ESTABLISHED THAT SUGGESTS THE NEED FOR CHANGE IN THE REGULATION;

(3) WHETHER THE ABSENCE OF REGULATION WOULD SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE;

(4) WHETHER THE REGULATION HAS INCREASED OR DECREASED THE COSTS OF ANY GOODS OR SERVICES;

(5) WHETHER THE STATUTE ESTABLISHES A CLEAR REGULATORY MANDATE AND THE BOARD COMPLIES WITH THE STATUTORY MANDATE;

(6) WHETHER THE BOARD HAS ESTABLISHED CLEAR OBJECTIVES AND THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE OBJECTIVES HAVE BEEN ACHIEVED;

(7) WHETHER OTHER ENTITIES, PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT HAVE THE SAME OR SIMILAR
