

INDUSTRIAL QUALITY EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICE AT ALL TIMES WHILE WORKING IN:

(1) A VOCATIONAL OR INDUSTRIAL ART SHOP OR LABORATORY THAT INVOLVES THE USE OF OR EXPOSURE TO:

(I) HOT MOLTEN METAL;

(II) MILLING, SAWING, TURNING, SHAPING, CUTTING, OR STAMPING OF ANY SOLID MATERIAL;

(III) HEAT TREATMENT, TEMPERING, OR KILN FIRING OF ANY METAL OR OTHER MATERIAL;

(IV) GAS OR ELECTRIC ARC WELDING;

(V) REPAIR OR SERVICING OF ANY VEHICLE; OR

(VI) ANY CAUSTIC OR EXPLOSIVE MATERIAL; OR

(2) A CHEMICAL OR COMBINED CHEMICAL-PHYSICAL LABORATORY THAT INVOLVES ANY CAUSTIC OR EXPLOSIVE CHEMICAL OR HOT LIQUID OR SOLID.

(C) SUPPLY AND PURCHASE OF PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES.

(1) THE SCHOOL MAY FURNISH INDUSTRIAL QUALITY EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICES TO ITS STUDENTS, AND TEACHERS, AND TO ANY VISITOR TO ITS CLASSROOMS OR LABORATORIES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) THE SCHOOL MAY BUY THESE PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES IN LARGE QUANTITIES AND SELL THEM AT COST TO ITS STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.

7-406. FIRE DRILLS.

(A) REQUIRED.

THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL REQUIRE EACH COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT TO HOLD A FIRE DRILL IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL AT LEAST 10 TIMES EACH SCHOOL YEAR AND AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 60 DAYS.

(B) RECORDS TO BE KEPT.

EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL:

(1) KEEP RECORDS OF THESE FIRE DRILLS; AND

(2) SEND A COPY TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT.
