INDUSTRIAL QUALITY EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICE AT ALL TIMES WHILE WORKING IN:

- (1) A VOCATIONAL OR INDUSTRIAL ART SHOP OR LABORATORY THAT INVOLVES THE USE OF OR EXPOSURE TO:
 - (I) HOT MOLTEN METAL:
- (II) MILLING, SAWING, TURNING, SHAPING, CUTTING, OR STAMPING OF ANY SOLID MATERIAL:
- (III) HEAT TREATMENT, TEMPERING, OR KILN FIRING OF ANY METAL OR OTHER MATERIAL:
 - (IV) GAS OR ELECTRIC ARC WELDING;
 - (V) REPAIR OR SERVICING OF ANY VEHICLE; OR
 - (VI) ANY CAUSTIC OR EXPLOSIVE MATERIAL; OR
- (2) A CHEMICAL OR COMBINED CHEMICAL-PHYSICAL LABORATORY THAT INVOLVES ANY CAUSTIC OR EXPLOSIVE CHEMICAL OR HOT LIQUID OR SOLID.
 - (C) SUPPLY AND PURCHASE OF PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES.
- (1) THE SCHOOL MAY FURNISH INDUSTRIAL QUALITY EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICES TO ITS STUDENTS, AND TEACHERS, AND TO ANY VISITOR TO ITS CLASSROOMS OR LABORATORIES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) THE SCHOOL MAY BUY THESE PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES IN LARGE QUANTITIES AND SELL THEM AT COST TO ITS STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.

7-406. FIRE DRILLS.

(A) REQUIRED.

THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL REQUIRE EACH COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT TO HOLD A FIRE DRILL IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL AT LEAST 10 TIMES EACH SCHOOL YEAR AND AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 60 DAYS.

(B) RECORDS TO BE KEPT.

EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL:

- (1) KEEP RECORDS OF THESE FIRE DRILLS; AND
- (2) SEND A COPY TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT.
