7-407. PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM.

7-409. DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM.

(A) STATE BOARD TO IMPLEMENT PROGRAM.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM OF DRUG EDUCATION IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

- (B) TEACHERS TO BE TRAINED IN DRUG EDUCATION.
- (1) THIS PROGRAM SHALL BE STARTED BEFORE THE SIXTH GRADE IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL BY TEACHERS WHO ARE TRAINED IN THE FIELD OF DRUG EDUCATION.
- (2) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR DETERMINING HOW A TEACHER IS CONSIDERED TO BE "TRAINED IN THE FIELD OF DRUG EDUCATION" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
 - (C) COORDINATION WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES.

THIS PROGRAM SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION AND CONTROL.
