

(2) IF NO ACTION TO THE CONTRARY IS TAKEN BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY JULY 1, 1979, §7-412 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS REPEALED AND SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS EFFECTIVE, BOTH TO TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1980.

(B) DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM REQUIRED.

EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE A PROGRAM OF DRIVER EDUCATION TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 16, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived from Section 8 of Ch. 972, Acts of 1977 and subsection (b) of this section is derived from Section 5 of Ch. 972, Acts of 1977.

Since Section 5 of Ch. 972, Acts of 1977 is subject to the contingency of the legislature taking "no action to the contrary by July 1, 1979", this section is included here as a separate section with the contingency included.

In any event, subsection (b) of this section is not effective until July 1, 1980.

SUBTITLE 5. SUBSIDIZED AND FREE FEEDING PROGRAMS.

7-501. STANDARDS SET BY STATE BOARD.

(A) ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT AND PUBLISH STANDARDS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE SUBSIDIZED AND FREE FEEDING PROGRAM.

(B) CONTENT.

THE STANDARDS SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE FOR ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROGRAM; AND

(2) REQUIRE EACH COUNTY BOARD TO PROVIDE A REDUCED PRICE LUNCH PROGRAM.

7-502. ESTABLISHMENT AND FUNDING OF PROGRAMS.

(A) STATE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A STATE FREE FEEDING PROGRAM.

(B) STATE SUPERINTENDENT TO DETERMINE FUNDS REQUIRED; DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS.
