THIS: AND

- (3) APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE PROGRAM SHOULD BE BRIEF AND SIMPLE, BASED ON A STATEMENT OF PRESENT INCOME AND FAMILY SIZE OR OF PARTICIPATION IN A SOCIAL SERVICES OR WELFARE PROGRAM.
 - (B) DISCRIMINATION AMONG STUDENTS PROHIBITED.

THERE MAY NOT BE DISCRIMINATION AMONG THESE PROGRAMS FOR ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR HIGH, AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

SUBTITLE 6. TRANSPORTATION.

7-601. TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS BY COUNTY GOVERNING BODY.

AT ITS OWN EXPENSE, A COUNTY GOVERNING BODY MAY PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN ADDITION TO THE TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BY THE STATE.

- 7-602. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS AND TEACHERS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.
 - (A) APPLICABILITY OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES:

- (1) CALVERT;
- (2) CAROLINE;
- (3) CHARLES, EXCEPT THAT THIS COUNTY MAY NOT OWN MORE THAN FOUR BUSES, EXCLUDING ANY VEHICLE PRIMARILY USED TO TRANSPORT HANDICAPPED STUDENTS OR ATHLETIC TEAMS;
 - (4) DORCHESTER;
 - (5) QUEEN ANNE'S;
