racing-days-granted to one-track may be run-at—another enly—in—case—of—emergency—or—extraordinary eircumstances;—requiring—statements—required—to be filed—with—the-Commission—to-be under-eath—and—signed by—certain—persons;—permitting race-tracks—to—qualify for—loans—from—the—Maryland—Industrial—Financing Authority; requiring that certain—conditions—be met—in order—to—qualify—for—financing—from—the—Maryland—Industrial—Financing—Authority;—clarifying—language; and—cenerally—relating—to—barness—racing—in-Maryland.

FOR the purpose of requiring each harness track to pay an estimated tax on wagers; requiring the State to provide any security quards requested by a licensee and requiring a licensee to reimburse the State for providing security quards; requiring statements to be filed under oath and signed by certain persons, prohibiting a licensee from making certain loans under certain conditions; and generally relating to harness racing in Maryland.
