

FINDINGS THAT ARE RELATED TO PROGRAMS OF COMPENSATORY EDUCATION INDEPENDENTLY OR IN COOPERATION WITH ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AGENCY OR ORGANIZATION THAT ENGAGES IN RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT DESIGNED TO OVERCOME DISADVANTAGE.

8-103. DUTIES OF STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:

(1) SUPERVISE AND CONTROL EACH PROGRAM OF COMPENSATORY EDUCATION PROVIDED IN THIS STATE;

(2) TAKE ANY ACTION NECESSARY TO COORDINATE THESE PROGRAMS;

(3) APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE, AS MAY BE APPROPRIATE, EACH COUNTY PROGRAM APPLICATION; AND

(4) PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND CONSULTATIVE ASSISTANCE TO THE COUNTY BOARDS.

In this section, the language "pursuant to the provisions of this chapter" is deleted as unnecessary.

8-104. GUIDANCE FOR COUNTY BOARDS.

(A) STANDARDS ESTABLISHED.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS TO GUIDE COUNTY BOARDS IN APPLYING FOR:

(1) ANY STATE FUNDS THAT ARE PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET SPECIFICALLY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) FUNDS PROVIDED UNDER THE FEDERAL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT OF 1965.

(B) APPLICABILITY OF STANDARDS.

THESE STANDARDS APPLY TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY DO NOT CONFLICT WITH THE FEDERAL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT OF 1965 OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THAT ACT.
