SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 43 - Health

For the purpose of this subtitle, the following words or phrases, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

(a) The term "beauty culture" includes any and all work done for compensation by any person which work is generally and usually performed by so-called hairdressers, cosmetologists, cosmetologists aides, cosmeticians, wig stylists not licensed as barbers, beauticians or beauty culturists and demonstrators of beauty preparations or equipment, and however denominated in so-called hairdressing and beauty shops, which work is for the embellishment,
