SUBTITLE 2. GIFTED AND TALENTED CHILDREN.

8-201. "GIFTED AND TALENTED CHILD" DEFINED.

IN THIS SUBTITLE "GIFTED AND TALENTED CHILD" MEANS AN ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY STUDENT WHO IS IDENTIFIED BY PROFESSIONALLY QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS AS HAVING OUTSTANDING ABILITIES IN THE AREA OF:

- (1) GENERAL INTELLECTUAL CAPABILITIES;
- (2) SPECIFIC ACADEMIC APTITUDES; OR
- (3) THE CREATIVE, VISUAL, OR PERFORMING ARTS.

8-202. STATEMENT OF POLICY.

A GIFTED AND TALENTED CHILD NEEDS DIFFERENT SERVICES BEYOND THOSE NORMALLY PROVIDED BY THE REGULAR SCHOOL PROGRAM IN ORDER TO DEVELOP HIS POTENTIAL.

8-203. DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAMS.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL ENCOURAGE EACH COUNTY BOARD TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT PROGRAMS FOR GIFTED AND TALENTED CHILDREN.
