judge of the District Court, and in so doing has the same rowers, responsibilities and liabilities as a sheriff or deputy sheriff acting in the same capacity if the constable has satisfactorily completed a training program from a police training school approved by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

SECTION 2. AND FE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
