- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IF AN INITIAL ENROLLMENT OF AT LEAST 25 CERTIFICATE HOLDERS SUBSCRIBERS REASONAELY CAN BE EXPECTED UNDER A NEW OR EXPANDED GROUP FOLICY CONTRACT.
- (F) EVERY NCNERCFIT HEALTH INSURER SERVICE PLAN PECVICING FOSFITAL FENEFITS PROPOSING TO ISSUE IN THIS STATE A GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY CONTRACT PROGRAM SHALL OFFER TO THE AFFICANT GROUP POLICYHOLETR THE CPTICN TO PROVIDE BENEFITS FOR TREATMENT OF DRUG ABUSE EQUAL TO AT LEAST THE FOLICWING COVERAGE:
- (1) IN A 12-MONTH BENEFIT PERICD, AT LEAST 21 DAYS INPATIENT TREATMENT IN A HOSPITAL OR RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE HAS CERTIFIED OF LICENSED FOR THAT PURPOSE; AND
- (2) IF THE POLICY IS A MAJOR MEDICAL INSURANCE FOLICY:
- (I) COVERAGE IN AN OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE HAS CERTIFIED OF LICENSED FOR THAT PURPOSE; AND
- (II) COVERAGE SHALL BE FOR AT LEAST 80 PERCENT OF THE CCST OF CARE, EUT IS NOT REQUIRED TO EXCEED \$1,000 IN ANY 12-MONTH PERIOD.
- (C) FOR PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PROPOSED CHANGE IN EENEFITS UNDER AN EXISTING POLICY CONTRACT IS A PROPOSAL TO ISSUE A POLICY CONTRACT.
- (D) FOR THE PURICSES OF THIS SECTION "DRUG ABUSE" MEANS AN UNCONTROLLARLE AND EXCESSIVE USE OF A DRUG OR DRUG DEFIVATIVE.

- (E) EVERY NONPROFIT HEALTH INSURER PROPOSING TO ISSUE OR DELIVER IN THIS STATE A GROUP OR BLANKET HOSPITAL OR MAJOF MEDICAL INSURANCE POLICY SHALL OFFER THE APPLICANT GROUP ECLICYHOLDER THE OPTION TO PROVIDE BENEFITS FOR TREATMENT OF DRUG ARUSE EQUAL TO AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING COVERAGE:
- (1) IN ANY 12-MONTH BENEFIT PERIOD, AT LEAST 21 DAYS INPATIENT TREATMENT IN A HOSPITAL OR RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE HAS CERTIFIED OR LICENSED FOR THAT PURPOSE; AND
