other members are entitled to receive [\$2,000] \$3,000 each annually as compensation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the members of the school heard in-office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the members of the school heard shall take effect at—the—beginning—of—the—next—following—term—of—office on January 1, 1979..

SECTION 3. AND FE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
