(House Bill 213)

AN ACT concerning

Scenic and Wild Rivers - Local Advisory Boards

FOR the purpose of defining the ~~minimum~~ maximum composition of a local scenic and wild river advisory board for a river in more than one county.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
