MCST CLOSELY COMPARES TO THEIR PORMER POSITION, WITHOUT FURTHER FXAMINATION OF CUALIFICATION. SUCH EMPLOYEES SHALL BE CRECITED WITH THE YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE JURISDICTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF DETERMINING LEAVE ACCUMULATION, SHALL ELCOME MEMBERS OF THE STATE EMPLOYEES PENSION SYSTEM AND ALL PREVIOUS PENSION CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL BE TRANSFERRED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 73B, AND SHALL RECEIVE NO DIMINUTION IN COMPENSATION OR ACCUMULATED LEAVE SOLELY AS A RESULT OF SUCH TRANSFER. ANNUAL LEAVE IN EXCESS OF THAT WHICH MAY BE RETAINED ANNUALLY IN THE STATE MERIT SYSTEM MAY BE RETAINED BY THE FORMER EMPLOYER.

PAYMENTS ARE COLLECTED BY THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PHOBATICN ON JULY 1, 1978 MAY ELECT TO TRANSFER THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR COLLECTION OF SUPPORT PAYMENTS TO AN AGENCY OF THE SUBDIVISION OR, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE COURT, TO THE CIRCUIT COURT FOF THAT SUBDIVISION. SUCH TRANSFER MAY BE MADE THROUGH NOTIFICATION BY THE SUBDIVISION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN BESCURCES NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1, 1578. SUCH TRANSFER WILL BE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1979. SUBSEQUENTLY, ANY SUCH TRANSFER WILL REQUIRE ENACTMENT OF SPECIFIC LEGISLATION.

(III) WHEN THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR CCLLECTION AND/OR SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT IS EXERCISED BY A LOCAL AGENCY OR CIRCUIT COURT:

(A) THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO FINANCE COLLECTION AND/OB SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT SHALL BE DERIVED FROM LCCAL AND, TO THE EXTENT AVAILABLE, FEDERAL RESOURCES.

THE PERSON REQUIRED TO MAKE SUPPORT PAYMENTS IN ORDER TO DEFRAY THE COST OF COLLECTION MAY BE RETAINED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

SUBDIVISIONS EXERCISING SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES
THE MAXIMUM COLLECTION INCENTIVES TO WHICH THE SUBDIVISION
MAY BE ENTITLED PURSUANT TO FEDERAL LAW.

[IV] FRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1979 THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CCITECTION OF SUPPORT PAYMENTS AND SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS PERTAINING TO THE STAFFING, RICORDKFEFING, REPORTING, INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION PROCEDURES, AND OTHER MANAGEMENT CPERATIONS NECESSARY TO ASSURE FEOPER AND EFFICIENT COLLECTION OF SUPPORT PAYMENTS.

WHEN THE RESECNSIEILITY FOR COLLECTION AND/OR SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT IS EXERCISED BY A LOCAL AGENCY OR CIRCUIT COURT, THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND STANDARDS SHALL NOT BE AFFLICABLE IF THAT LOCAL AGENCY OR CIRCUIT COURT HAS PROMULGATED RULES, REGULATIONS, AND STANDARDS WHICH ABE IN GENERAL CONFORMITY WITH THOSE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
